

## Frequently Asked Questions

- 1) Students who are going to complete their M.Sc. in Physics in the year 2020 are eligible for SSP-2020 programme?  
No.  
SSP-2020 is limited to students who are completing their M.Sc. Physics in the year 2021
- 2) Students who are going to complete their Bachelor's degree in Engineering in the year 2020 are eligible for SSP-2020 programme?  
No.  
SSP-2020 is limited to students who are completing their B.E. / B.Tech. (Mechanical and Electrical only) in the year 2021
- 3) Students pursuing Bachelor's degree other than Mechanical & Electrical can apply for SSP-2020 programme?  
No.
- 4) What to be filled in the application form if there is no middle name and last name?  
Write "(NA)" if you do not have any last name. You can leave the row of 'Middle name' empty.
- 5) Which documents to be send along with hardcopy of application form?
  - (a) Hard copy of the online filled application form, duly signed and forwarded by the head of your institution or department.
  - (b) Photocopies of all the required mark sheets (10<sup>th</sup> Marksheet, 12<sup>th</sup> Marksheet / Diploma in Engineering Marksheets, B.E. / B.Tech. / B.Sc. / M.Sc. Marksheets (all) till date.
  - (c) Affix passport size photo in the hard copy of online filled application form.
  - (d) And any other supporting documents relevant to your honours and medals.
- 6) What to do if there is mistake in submitted application form? Any changes possible in submitted application form?  
You can make the changes in hard copy and write an email to [iprssp@ipr.res.in](mailto:iprssp@ipr.res.in) mentioning your application ID.
- 7) Can the students send their supporting documents in black & white?  
Yes
- 8) Self-attestation is mandatory on all the supporting documents?  
Yes
- 9) Am I eligible to apply for SSP-2020 at IPR if none of the results of M.Sc. has been declared?  
Yes, provided your passing out year is 2021. You may write numeric '1' in the row 'Marks obtained'.
